Inviting Children to Respond to the Gospel: Charles Brett

Why don't children respond to the gospel message? Often the gospel is not clearly presented or we do not give clear directions as to how to respond to the gospel after it is presented. Children thrive on relationship. If you do not give them an opportunity to talk with you, they may never understand God's invitation. Come hear about how to give an invitation and what to do if no one ever responds.

Where has Evangelism Gone?: Dr. Keith Marlett

Many teachers and churches think they are presenting the gospel, but are they? Many teachers don't even try to present it. Evangelism is not a popular topic in the church today, because we do not want to offend anyone. Has the mission changed from the early church?
